Remember to plan a family program.

August is the month set aside to dedicate a special week of the year to recognize the vital importance of families as the foundation of our domestic church and to promote Catholic family values. Though traditionally celebrated in the summer to commemorate the birth and death of our founder, Blessed Michael J. McGivney, this program can take place anytime during the year. Specific Days to be aware of are: August 12th Fr. Michael McGivney's Birthday, August 13th Memorial Day for Father designated by the Archdiocese of Hartford, August 14th Fr. Michael McGivney's Anniversary of his Death, but highlight the 12th, 13th, or 14th of any month of the year that works for your council. We could have a Triduum on these days utilizing "The Canonization Prayer" or "The Litany of Blessed Michael McGivney Prayer". Both are found here on our Website http://www.michaeljmcgivneyhonoris.ca. August is also the month for a Novena to Father McGivney.

Through his intercession, grant the favour I now present (Here make your request...). Through Christ our Lord. Amen. Say 1 Our Father... 1 Hail Mary... 1 Glory Be...
